

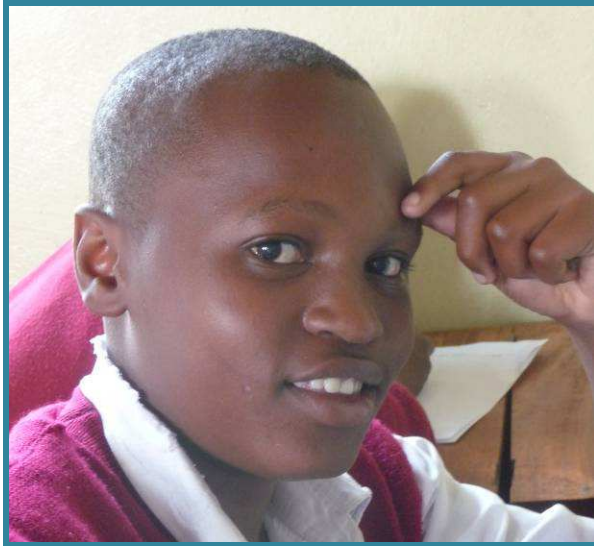
A little bit... from the Turners

It's the end of the year and we've been in Tanzania for almost two years now. We are still learning Swahili and about how Tanzanians think about things and live their lives. It is a privilege to be growing in relationships in our neighbourhood, at school and at church.



The support that you and others give has enabled us to live here and be involved in the lives of people like "Musa", a student at Mara Anglican Primary School. Musa is a Muslim and has been asking a lot of questions about Christianity and what it means to have assurance of salvation. He is really grappling with some big issues. His exam results weren't so great this year and he now faces the possibility that his father will make him leave school to stay at home and cook for his family. **We thank God that He has brought Musa into our life at this time and pray that Glen may have ongoing opportunities to encourage him.**

We care about people like Musa and we can only be here, building relationships and seeking gospel opportunities, because people like you generously give. At present we are seeking more partners in ministry who will give regular financial support.
